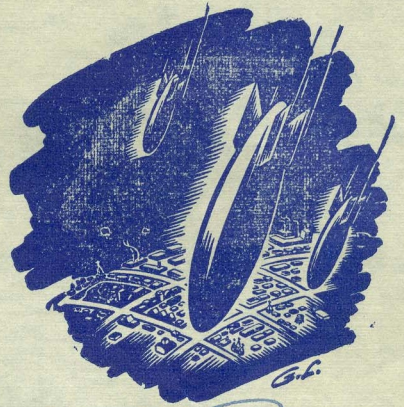

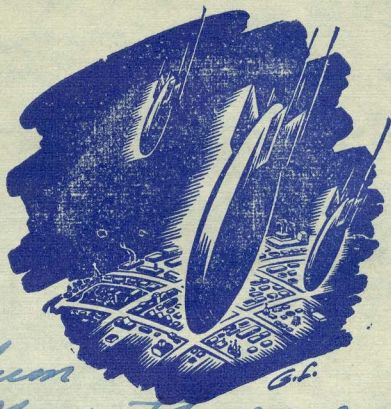
The other day, it was

globe.

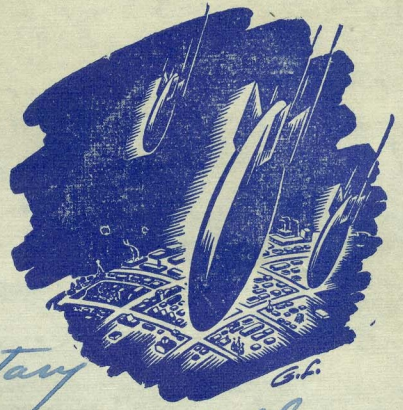
In respect of their location
