So many useful things that we don't think of until we haven't got them. At the present I am in Holland & soap is a luxury the people here cannot get it. For a piece of soap you can get your laundry done & they think they are well paid.

I would like very much to get Henry's address I had it once in England but since then I have misplaced it. I hear of a number of boys from home who are overseas in the army but I have not met any of them as yet.

the letter.

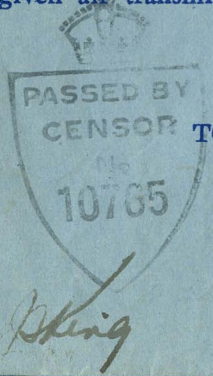
There are so
