By - Laws:

- (1) Meeting Time 9 P.M.
- (2) Dues Shall be \$3.00 per person per year to be paid by the November Meeting.
- (3) Assessment Policy Special assessments have the affirmative vote of 2/3 of those present and voting.
- (4) Attendance An active member is required to attend at least 3 meetings during the year. If they do not, their membership shall be reviewed and acted upon by the organization.
- (5) Contributions by the Club shall be made by only and affirmative vote of 2/3 of the active members present and voting.
- (6) Annual Affairs Chirstmas Party. Summer Picnic.
- (7) Colours and Crest The clubs offical colours shall be Green and White.
- (8) Bursary Award To the coloured student graduating from a Secondary School upon application to the Club by letter accompanied by a letter of recommendation from the school Principal. Letters of application and recommendation to be received by the club before last Saturday in May.

All local schools to be notified of availability and qualifications for Bursary by Feburary.

Decision shall be made by the Club, taking matters of concern into consideration to determine most eligible.

Award shall be \$100 paid in two installments.

- (9) Bank All funds to be deposited in a bank located in Windsor. The Banking committee shall consist of the following officers. The President, Recording Secretary, and the Tressure. It shall be necessary to have any two of these officers sign sheques, for withdrawls.
- (10) Club Property All P roperty purchased or donated to the club shall become club property. A record shall be kept by the Recording Secretary of this property. The President shall be responsible for the location of all club property.
- (11) Committee Reports and Responsibilities / The Chairman shall present a report in detail of the committee's plans and budget prior to any committments or expenditures to the regular meeting for approval. Committee shall not exceed the approved budget by more than 10%.
