Dear Mrs Christian,-

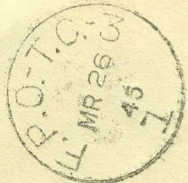

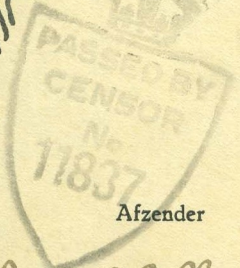
